The very exciting news for Delgado Tennis is that Jamie Delgado has been hired as Jack Draper's new lead coach ahead of the 2026 ATP season. Jack Draper is the British number 1 and currently sits at 11 in the world following a period of time off injured. The appointment was announced in October 2025, and it marks a new chapter for Draper, who is recovering from an arm injury that ended his 2025 season. Jamie Delgado previously coached Andy Murray during his rise to world number one and also worked with Grigor Dimitrov. We can't wait to see Draper back on the court and be part of the Delgado Tennis journey!

The Professionals also started this term at the US Open. The finalists on the Women's side were world number 1, Aryna Sabalenka against American world number 8, Amanda Anisimova. Sabalenka won 6 – 3 in the First, the second set was a battle going to a tie break with Sabalenka winning 7-6 (7-3)

As for the Men's side, it was no surprise to see the 2 best players in the world in the final slam of the year. Carlos Alcaraz beat Jannik Sinner 6 - 2, 3 - 6, 6 - 1, 6 - 4. These two have dominated the sport this year with each winning 2 slams this year out of the 4!
